


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| Title: Animals: Can-Have-Are | Grade: Kindergarten |
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| Content: English Language Arts | Duration: 15 minutes |
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| <p>Standard:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● W.K.10: Uses the rules of written english ● RI.K.7: Matches drawings to ideas in the text ● RI.K.2: Identifies and retells key details of a text |
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| <p>Objective: The student will identify and recall details and characteristics of animals from nonfiction texts.</p> |

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| <p>Introduction/Description: In this activity, the child will identify and recall details and characteristics of animals. The student will make or complete a graphic organizer to show learning and understanding.</p> |
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| <p>Steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read or listen to the animal book ● Complete the organizer with facts from the book. ● Write 3 complete sentences using the facts or ideas from the organizer. ● Example: A turtle can dig with its back legs. ● Draw a careful detailed picture that goes with the sentence. |
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| <p>Finished Product: The student will have a completed organizer and at least one sentence to share with the teacher.</p> |
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| <p>Adaptations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Have the child label the drawing instead of writing a complete sentence. ● Challenge the child to write more sentences based on the facts from their organizer. ● Look for more information on the animal. ● Allow the child to complete the activity with an animal of choice. |
